



Dear guests,

We are grateful and excited to welcome you back to Linwood Spiritual Center.

Our staff and the SU community have worked diligently to keep Linwood safe these many months and are even more committed to do so for you as well.

Here are a few of actions we are taking to do all we can to keep us all safe so that you can enjoy and appreciate the beauty of Linwood as you always have:

- All surfaces and bathrooms are sanitized daily.
- All dining areas and serveries are sanitized after every meal.
- There is a mandatory 24 hours between groups for sanitizing.
- Although bathrooms are shared, you will be assigned your own personal shower, toilet, and sink throughout your stay which can only be used by you or an approved member of your household.
- Seating is socially distant unless you sit with a member of your household or have been vaccinated.
- We have sanitizing stations throughout the buildings.

ALL GUESTS, VACCINATED OR NOT ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS AND BE SOCIALLY DISTANT ON THE BUFFET LINE IN THE SERVERY

Linwood Spiritual Center does not require vaccinations of our staff or guests but is compliant with the State of New York and CDC guidelines.

If staff or guests are vaccinated they are not required to keep to the following protocols but may do so voluntarily.

Pre-arrival, guests are required to fill out and submit a health survey and Liability Waiver. *If individuals are from the same household they will fill out an additional waiver stating so allowing them to share a room, bathroom, dining room table, and together while on property.*

Upon arrival to Linwood

If you have been vaccinated present proof of vaccination at registration. If not:

- Please put on a mask.
- Staff will test your temperature
- You will fill out health survey sheet.
- If you do not meet the health requirements arrangements will be made for you to contact your health provider and leave the property.
- Check in.
- While sitting/meeting/eating socially distant (6 feet apart)
- When outside.
- In your bedroom/while bathing.
- You must wear a mask if someone else is in the bathroom and walking while back and forth from the bathrooms.
- Guest must not enter another guest's bedroom unless you are considered to be from the same household.
- If you choose to go off the property for any reason you must repeat the process.
